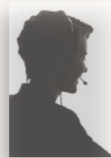

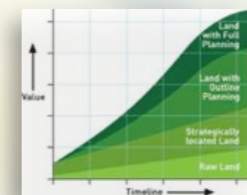

Local land values soar as new market reforms take effect in "success-sharing free zones"

3 ...for shared gains

Local and global allies benefit from new free market breakthroughs

Local free zone stakeholders

Community voucher funds grow as reforms lift values of "land grant" endowments

Individuals and families win additional vouchers as their language or telework skills improve

Entrepreneurial schools gain funding as enrolled students increase, skill levels rise, and work-study projects win high ratings

Governments that give sites for free zones get shares in rising land values

Global beneficiaries

University groups earn shares in land grants by giving virtual help to schools, eGovernment pilots, and site development planning

Policy institutes that provide reform guidance and telework jobs gain reform examples and a new talent pool (via voucher-funded work/study projects)

Online course providers share in revenue from tuition vouchers

Seed funders get interests in Quickstart free zones, and options on expansion area development
