






How To Tape Your New Rifle

This is a step-by-step guide to taping your rifle! The more careful you are when taping, the better it will turn out - so avoid wrinkles! Good luck!

Needed For This Project: Phillips S.D., White & Black Elec. Tape, Scissors, Strapping Tape	The Rifle
	

1. Unscrew the bolt...	...and remove it like this.
	

2. Unscrew the strap...	...on both ends.
	

The bolt and strap removed!



3. Using 4 in. strips, use the strapping tape on the small end of the rifle.



Use 4 strips to cover it both ways, be sure to overlap slightly...



...like this!



Next, do the same to the "butt" end of the rifle.



Four inch strips do the trick!



Be sure to go both ways!



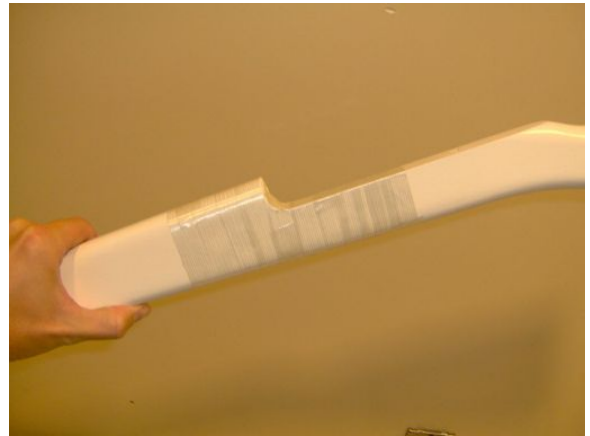
4. Using individually cut strips of strapping tape, wrap 4-5 inches of the barrel.



5. Same thing on the "butt"...individual strips for 4-5 inches



6. Now for the middle of the rifle...



...let the tape go where it wants, don't force it or it will wrinkle badly.



A fully strapping taped rifle!



7. White electrical tape on the ends, just like the strapping tape (overlap!)



8. Wrap the barrel, starting at the end, wrap in a spiral motion.



9. Electrical tape the "butt" end of the rifle...



...both ways!



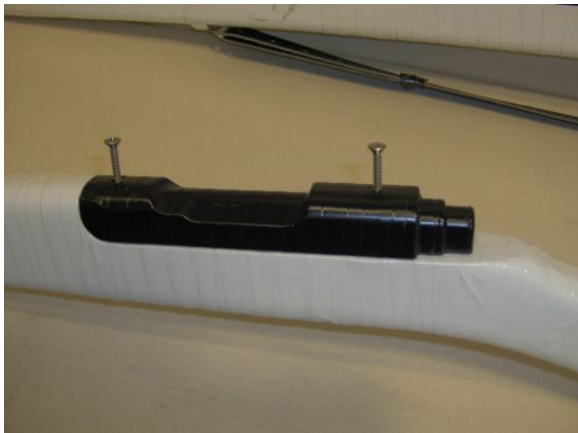
10. Spiral wrap the butt, about 5 inches.



A fully taped rifle!



11. Screw the bolt back onto the rifle...



...like so!



12. Now tape the screws on the strap.



13. Screw the strap back onto the rifle.



14. Tape the screws with a strip of white tape...



... and you are ready to go!!!
