International Teaching

I was nominated for the (America) Professional Teacher of the Year Award in 2004.

Since 2004 I have taught in Ramallah, USA, Iran, Kuwait, Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Egypt, Syria, Libya, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, South Africa, Brazil, France, Turkey, Spain, South Africa, Portugal, New Zealand and Australia. I taught at Houston Festival of Quilts in 2007 and 2008 and in 2010. In 2009, 2010, and 2011 I taught in NZ, UK, France, Belgium, Holland, Switzerland, Portugal, Thailand, Germany, Shanghai, Taiwan, Korea, Japan and Australia.

Lecturing

I have lectured in most countries where I have travelled. I have been a sought-after lecturer in Quilt Conventions and Universities since I have begun to travel and teach. There have been too many locations to list. Subject matter includes my own work (Pack and Follow), The Tentmakers of Egypt, Textiles in Syria, Egypt or India, and teaching sewing techniques intended to earn a living in Palestine, or Iran. Most recently I lectured at the University of Sydney, The Art Gallery of NSW and for ADFAS (Australian Decorative and Fine Arts Society) in eighteen locations including Goma Brisbane in 2011.
