



Dear Parents,

Wow! It has been another great year full of reading! As of today, Hallsburg students have read over 8,327 books consisting of more than 46,999,481 words!

In an effort to encourage reading during the summer, Hallsburg offers a summer reading program and allows our students access to our library books. The library is open Monday-Thursday 8:00-2:30. To participate in the summer reading program, complete the information requested on green reading log that is being sent home with your student and *return by August 18, 2017*. Each student has a required number of pages (or books for Kindergarten – see log for details) based on the grade they will be entering in the fall of 2017. *****Participants who turn their log in on time at the beginning of school will be eligible for summer reading rewards*****

AR testing is not allowed during the summer. However, if approved by their teacher, they can test on books read during the summer when they return to school in the fall.

Research has shown that students who read during the summer score higher on comprehension tests and retain more of what they learned during the school year. So please encourage your child(ren) to READ, READ, READ.
