If any item, such as the tax returns or financial aid information, is not yet available, submit the Information Sheet along with the items that are available and indicate which items will be submitted later. Please be aware that all other items must be received in order for the next semester check to be released. Also, note that if during the Fall or Spring semester you receive a GPA below 2.25, you are required to contact the Foundation (713-521-4601) as you may need to schedule a summer interview with the Executive Director of the Foundation.

- Spring semester grades (unofficial transcript is acceptable that includes the school name, student name and the Spring GPA and cumulative GPA-must be legible).
- Complete signed copy of parent’s previous year U.S. tax return, including all Schedules.
- Complete signed copy of student’s previous year U.S. tax return. *X here if you did not file*
- Copy of your college or university financial aid package, and a separate list of all outside scholarships (including amount per semester).
