



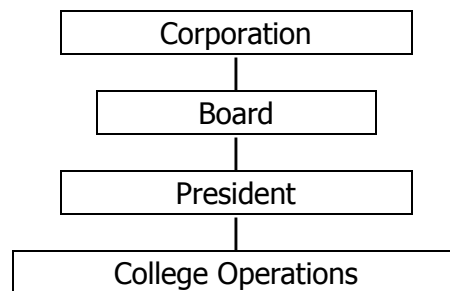
# LANCASTER BIBLE COLLEGE

## Corporation Job Description

**College Purpose:** Lancaster Bible College exists to educate Christian students to think and live a biblical worldview and to proclaim Christ by serving Him in the Church and society.

**Corporation Purpose:** The Corporation of Lancaster Bible College is the legal ownership body of the College and as such exists to support the ministry of the College as a "truly Christian institution of higher learning with the Bible as the perpetual rule for its faith and practice, and with the aim of training believers in the Lord Jesus Christ for definite Christian work."

### Structure:



### Responsibilities of Members:

1. The Corporation shall delegate to the Board of Trustees the responsibilities of policy formation and operational approval as set forth in the Constitution and Bylaws and receive from the Board regular reports of Board activities.
2. State regulations require that the Corporation, as an entire group, must support the College with not less than \$25,000 per year. The Corporation shall each year, as a group and according to state regulations, provide written evidence of their financial support of the College.
3. Corporation members shall attend two meetings a year. They are the Annual Fall Corporation meeting and the Annual Spring Celebration Dinner/Concert held in the spring.
4. Corporation members shall pray regularly for the College and its ministries and encourage others to become faith and prayer partners.

5. Corporation members shall promote the College in the communities where members reside and work and seek to secure new friends and funds for the advancement of the College ministry.
6. Corporation members shall pledge themselves to regular and significant financial support of the College. There is no set amount established for individual giving, but it is anticipated that Corporation members will consider the College as a high priority in their annual giving plan.
7. Corporation members shall support the Trustees by attendance at College functions, attendance at special or regular meetings of the Corporation, and by serving on regular committees of the Trustees or other such committees that may be constituted for special projects.
8. Corporation members shall work with the College in seeking out and encouraging men and women to enroll in the College.
9. Corporation members shall represent the College in the community and serve as a vital interpreter and promoter of the ministry of the College as opportunities arise.

**Relationship:**

1. Corporation members are in a trust relationship and as such shall be responsible to the Lord, to the constituency, and the public for the overall operation of the College ministry.
2. Corporation members shall communicate with the College through the Chairman of the Corporation any ideas, suggestions or concerns.
3. The Corporation as a body shall be responsible for the final actions and activities of the Board of Trustees and thus the College operations.

**Privileges:**

1. Corporation members shall be informed regularly of the ministries and operations of the College.
2. Corporation members shall be invited to participate in the College through College ministries and public programs.
3. Corporation members share in the experience and joy of the ministry of the College in seeing this part of God's vineyard prosper.
