At its recent meeting, the ABHE Commission reviewed requests for reaffirmation of accreditation status and requests for substantive change. Based on its review, the ABHE Commission has acted **to reaffirm the accredited status of Lancaster Bible College and Graduate School until 2018**. In taking this action, the Commission requested **a progress report due November 1, 2009** with concern for the effectiveness of the planning and assessment program. It should document that the institution has gone through a full cycle of collecting, analyzing, and using data for improvement (Standards 2 and 12).

*The Commission also reviewed the follow-up report for a major substantive change. The Commission approved the progress reported and commended Lancaster Bible College & Graduate School for the thoroughness of its follow-up report.*

Refer to the enclosed *2008 Report Guide* and specifically address the Commission's concern in the report. Please note the late fee policy for materials. In light of your participation in the evaluation process, we would appreciate the completion of the enclosed *Assessment Survey*.
