Collection of Bottled Water

Jackson County, the Town of Sylva, WCU Center for Service Learning and Tuckasegee Water and Sewer Authority invite you to join with us as we offer a helping hand to those who have been hurt so badly by Hurricane Florence in North Carolina. Each of the partners in this process will be making contributions to this effort by providing collection points and / or logistical support.

Until further notice we'll be collecting contributions of bottled water at the following locations for the purpose of sending these to the affected areas of North Carolina.

- TWSA Main Office, 1246 West Main Street, Sylva, NC
- Town of Sylva Town Hall, 83 Allen Street, Sylva, NC
- Jackson County- Cashiers Recreation Center, 355 Frank Allen Road, Cashiers, NC
Skyland Drive Service Center, 876 Skyland Drive, Sylva, NC

A first round of donations will close out the afternoon of Thursday Sept 27, 2018 so the collected items can be palletized for the next step.

NC Department of Public Safety- Division of Emergency Management is coordinating these types of large donations and using the Red Cross to perform the logistics work to get the supplies to the locations with the greatest needs. These local contributions will be collected, assembled into pallets and then transported to the affected areas of North Carolina. They'll be distributed to the communities which have been hit hard by this weather event.

A follow on round of collections will be announced if there continues to be a need. We are grateful for any contributions to this effort that are made by our community.
