

ORDER

The following minute order is made by the direction of the court, the Honorable Richard A. Jones:

Defendants answered Plaintiff's complaint on May 10, 2010, and on the same day filed a motion (Dkt. # 12) to dismiss Plaintiff's claim for counterfeiting goods in violation of the Lanham Act. On May 21, 2010, Plaintiff filed an amended complaint that did not contain a counterfeiting claim. Plaintiff was permitted to file her amended complaint without leave of court because she did so within 21 days of Defendants' answer. Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a)(1)(B). As the amended complaint contains no counterfeiting claim, Defendants' motion (Dkt. # 12) is moot, and the court accordingly DENIES it.
