

Can comics make science and engineering more accessible? The students of Human Centered Design & Engineering (HCDE) believe that they can.

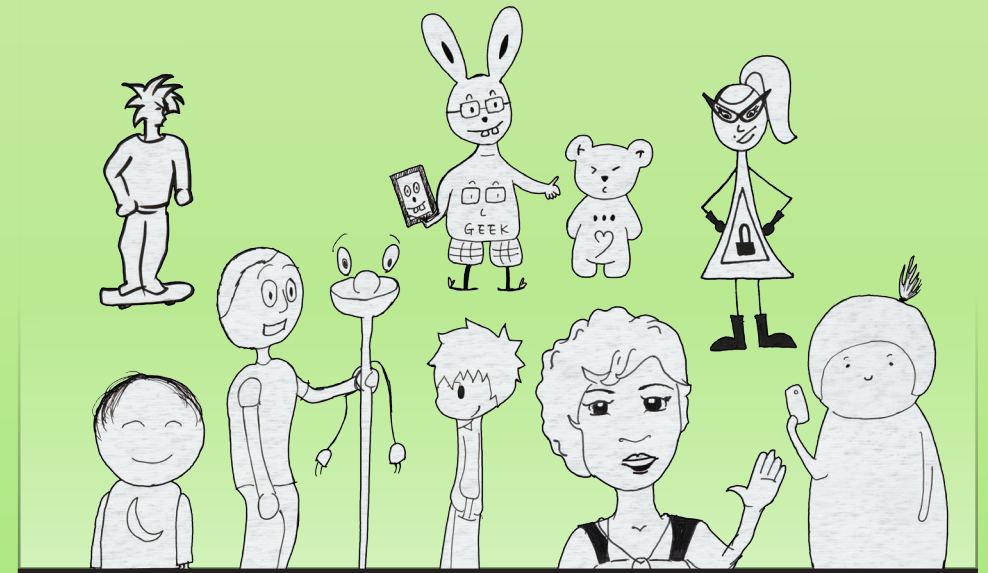
