As a practicing Physical therapist at the Human Performance Center for the past 25 years and owner of ATTACHI Ergonomic Consulting & Injury Prevention for the past 11 years, I am frequently asked by patients and clients alike how do I chose a chair that will be comfortable, provide adequate support and be right for me!

Before I give you my top 5 chair picks there are 3 important factors to consider:

1. Your work surface height. Most standard work surfaces range between 29-30 inches in height. If you are using a keyboard tray or have an adjustable height work surface this give you more flexibility regarding your chair choice.

2. The chair height range. Chair height range varies depending on the chair you choose. If you are 5'2" and sit at a 29 inch height work surface and don't want to use a keyboard tray it is very important you choose a chair that raises high enough to get your elbows to a height of 29" from the floor, when your shoulders are relaxed, otherwise your elbows will be lower than your work surface and you will expend extra energy using your neck and shoulder muscles to elevate your arms to the height of the work surface (I commonly see this). This can leave you with a stiff neck and shoulders at the end of the day. This can also leave you vulnerable to a common risk factor "Contact Stress" of your forearms compressing against the edge of the work surface leave you vulnerable to "Carpel Tunnel Syndrome" due to compression of your forearm wrist flexor tendons becoming inflamed and irritating the median nerve. You will also need a footrest.

3. Your height. Very important. If you are between 5'8"-5'10" you are in luck as most office furniture was designed for you and most chairs raise to 19-20" thus enabling you to keep your feet on the floor and raise your chair height so your elbows are level with the work surface without needing a keyboard tray. If you are 5'2" and you sit at a standard height work surface you will most likely need a keyboard tray unless your chair raises to 22 or more inches in height.

The below photo that provides a general guideline of proper computer alignment:



Here are my top 5 chair picks . A good chair is like a good shoe. You may go to buy a pair of shoes and be given 5 different good quality shoes to try on, but only one feels comfortable to you. The same is true for chairs. When purchasing a new chair I recommend you try the chair out for at least 5 days before committing to a purchase. If you are willing to leave a credit card and can have the chair transported most companies will allow you to try a floor model of their chair for 5-7 days.

Important Chair Features To Consider:

- Adjustable chair height 18-20" range.
- Adjustable armrest height (height range from seat pan) 6-9".
- Adjustable seat depth
- Adjustable seat tilt feature.
- Adjustable back rest up/down & forward/backward.

If your work surface is curvilinear (rounded) you will want armrests with a pivot/swivel feature or be able to lower the armrest below your work surface and use your work surface for upper extremity support.
