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Pediatric Otolaryngology (ENT) General Pre-operative Instructions

If you have any questions or concerns regarding your surgery or any of the pre-operative instructions, please call our office.

• General Information

All Pediatric Otolaryngology (ENT) surgery is performed in Tisch Hospital at the NYU Langone Medical Center. A map of the medical center is included in this packet. The Day Surgery Operating Rooms are located on the 10th floor of Tisch Hospital and are easily accessed by the Tisch elevators.

Surgery Confirmation and Arrival the Day of Surgery

Friday prior to the date of your surgery, our team will contact you to confirm the date.

You should arrive at the hospital 1½-2 hours prior to your scheduled surgery time. This will allow time to fill out paperwork and get checked in by the OR staff. After surgery or prior to hospital discharge, your doctor will tell you when you need to return to the office for follow-up. You will need to call the next day to schedule this follow-up appointment.

Medical Clearance

A Medical Clearance form is attached to this packet. Please ensure that your pediatrician completes a clearance form within 30 days of the planned surgical date. If it is not completed within this time frame, the surgery may be delayed or even rescheduled.

Labs

If labs are ordered, they should be completed within 30 days prior to the date of surgery. If they are not completed within this time frame, the surgery may be delayed or even rescheduled.

Diet

Medications

If you routinely take prescription medications, you may take them up to 4 hours prior to your arrival time unless you have been directed otherwise by your surgeon or anesthesiologist. Please do not take any aspirin/ibuprofen products (Advil, Motrin, Aleve, Goody powders, etc.) 2 weeks prior to your surgery date.

• Discharge after surgery

After surgery, all patients are watched for at least 2 hours to make sure that they recover well from anesthesia and surgery. Please bring a bottle or sippy cup for infants or small children for use after surgery. Once they have determined to be doing well, discharge to home will be expedited. A parent or legal guardian must accompany any minor home after surgery.

• Illness and Cancellations

If you become ill (fever, cold, sore throat, etc.), please contact our office as soon as possible to discuss your symptoms, as surgery may or may not need to be postponed. If you need to cancel surgery, please try to call 72 hours in advance if at all possible.



PEDIATRIC NPO GUIDELINES:

THE DIVISION OF PEDIATRIC ANESTHESIOLOGY HAS DEVELOPED THE FOLLOWING **UNIFORM GUIDELINES** REGARDING PREOPERATIVE FASTING AND REQUIRED CONSULTATION BEFORE SURGERY:

Preoperative fasting guidelines for children of all ages:

No solid food after midnight

Whole milk: 8 hrs before scheduled arrival at the hospital

Formula: 6 hrs before scheduled arrival at the hospital

Breast milk: 4 hours before scheduled arrival at the hospital

<u>Clear liquids</u>: **2 hours** before scheduled arrival at the hospital

THE FOLLOWING POINTS WILL HELP TO ANSWER QUESTIONS ABOUT THESE GUIDELINES.

- WE RECOMMEND OFFERING LIQUIDS TO ALL CHILDREN, REGARDLESS OF AGE, ACCORDING TO THE ABOVE SCHEDULE, TO MINIMIZE DEHYDRATION AND MAXIMIZE COMFORT.
- FORMULA INCLUDES ALL MILK OR SOY-BASED PREPARATIONS.
- 'CLEAR LIQUIDS' INCLUDES WATER, PEDIALYTE AND APPLE JUICE **ONLY**.
- JELLO CONTAINS PROTEINS THAT DO NOT EMPTY RAPIDLY FROM THE STOMACH AND COUNT AS FORMULA.
