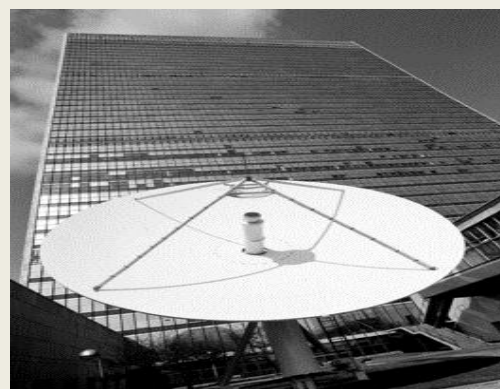


Innovative Business Models that Drive Inclusion and Participation
