## AN EVENING WITH JUSTICE REBECCA DALLET OF THE WISCONSIN SUPREME COURT



Rebecca Dallet was voted in as the new Wisconsin Supreme Court justice, taking her position in August, 2018. CBINT Sisterhood is excited to welcome Justice Dallet to talk to us about her first six months, cases to date and the gender gap of the judiciary. Justice Dallet grew up in Ohio, graduating from Shaker Heights High School. She received a Bachelor's Degree in Economics from Ohio State University, and a law degree from the Case Western Reserve University School of Law. After law school, Justice Dallet served as a Law Clerk for a U.S. Magistrate Judge. She worked as an assistant U.S. attorney, assistant district attorney with the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and as an adjunct professor of law at Marquette University Law School. Dallet was elected as a Judge for the Milwaukee County Circuit Court in 2008, then re-elected in 2014.

Prior to her election, Dallet served as President of the Milwaukee Trial Judges Association and Secretary of the Association of Women Lawyers. Dallet previously served one year as the first female presiding court commissioner in Milwaukee County history. Justice Dallet lives in Whitefish Bay with her husband, Brad Dallet, and three daughters.
