

SALE OF HAMETZ AUTHORIZATION

Rabbi Joel Alter will authorize the sale of hametz during the two weeks prior to Pesah. If you plan to mail this form, it must be received at the synagogue office no later than **9:30 AM on Friday, April 19, 2019 (no exceptions)** in order to be included. The sale of hametz will be completed with a non-Jewish person. All contributions will go to the MAOT HITIM FUND, which furnishes Pesah Food to needy families and institutions. For example: MAZON: A Jewish Response to Hunger, The Jewish Community Food Pantry and Jewish Family Services.

KNOW ALL PEOPLE BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, the undersigned, do hereby make and appoint Rabbi Alter my true and lawful representative to act in my place and stead, for me and in my name and in my behalf, to see all hametz owned and possessed by me, knowingly or unknowingly, as stated in the Torah and defined by the sages of Israel (e.g. hametz, hashash hametz-suspect hametz; and all kinds of ta'aromet hametz-hametz mixtures); also, hametz that tends to harden and to adhere to the surface of pans, pots or other cooking or eating utensils, or whatsoever nature, and to lease all places wherein the aforementioned hametz owned or possessed by me be found, especially in the premises located at (*your address*)

Rabbi Alter has the full authority and power to sell said hametz and to lease said place or places wherein said hametz may be found, upon such terms and conditions as discretion dictates. Rabbi Alter has the full power and authority to assign or appoint a substitute or substitutes to act in my behalf with all the same powers and authority that I have invested in the rabbi, and I do hereby ratify and confirm all that Rabbi Alter or rabbinic substitute lawfully does or causes to be done by virtue of these presents.
