Youth Community Code of Conduct

The applicant for membership in either Ruach, Kadima, or USY, agrees to be bound by the following Code of Conduct at all programs/activities held at Congregation Beth Israel Ner Tamid, including during free time, during transportation to and from events, and during events held at venues other than Congregation Beth Israel Ner Tamid.

1. **Safety.** The safety of all participants is of primary importance. No one may act in any manner that is deemed dangerous or hazardous to his/her own safety, or to the safety of any other program participant.
2. **Respect.** (a) The rights and feelings of all program participants must be respected at all times. Conduct disrespecting the rights and feelings of others will not be tolerated at any time. (b) All property rights are to be respected, including personal belongings, facilities, equipment. (c) Each participant will respect and fully cooperate with every staff member, including volunteer staff, and will adhere to all rules established for the event.
3. **Attendance and Participation.** Only individuals with a paid membership and who are registered for an event or activity, when called for, are permitted to attend. The Youth Director must approve attendance by others, in advance. Membership into Ruach, Kadima, and USY is exclusive to Jewish individuals. Participation in Ruach, Kadima, and USY programs and activities are limited to Jewish individuals unless program/activity is stated otherwise or prior consent is given. Participants may not leave an event at any time, or travel by an alternative method from designated transportation, without prior permission from the event's supervising Advisor along with prior permission from the individual's parent/guardian.
4. **Religious Observance.** All participants shall observe the religious policies established by the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism. These policies include, but are not limited to, those pertaining to Shabbat observance, Laws of Kashrut, the wearing of kippot during meals and religious services by all males (females are encouraged to do so, as well), those of age donning Tallit/Tefillin during morning services. Appropriate attire is required for all religious services.
5. **Illegal Conduct.** Possession or use of weapons, alcohol, vaping paraphernalia, tobacco products, illegal drugs or controlled substances, illegal conduct or misconduct will result in immediate removal from the event or activity and may cause a forfeiture of the right to participate in future Youth Group activities/events. If prescribed medication needs to be taken during an event, you must notify the event's supervisor. If you want the supervising adult to administer the medication, instructions for proper dosage and usage from a doctor or parent, must be included.

Violation of any portion of the Code of Conduct will subject the participant to immediate disciplinary measure, including, but not limited to, being barred from participation, being sent home at parents' expense, liability for monetary damages and suspension from future events and activities.
