MUSY's Kadima Committee is a wonderful opportunity for your middle schooler to develop leadership skills, make new friends, and have an impact on Kadima chapter programs.

EXPECTATIONS AND DUTIES

All committee members are expected to attend meetings, as many Kadima programs as possible, and Kadima Konvention. Members must also have a fully paid membership (\$40) by September 8, 2019. Furthermore, committee members must exhibit proper conduct with speech and attire at all Kadima functions and serve as a good example to the younger members of Ruach.

The main function of the committee is to help in the planning and implementation of chapter programs, to learn how to listen to others and work together in a respectful manner, to build leadership skills and discover ones strengths.

Duties of Kadima Committee members are intended to be light. Duties/responsibilities will rotate and be assigned based on their interests and comfort level. Responsibilities may include program planning, implementation of a program, taking meeting notes, volunteering at Ruach programs, creating flyers, assist in mailings, helping to keep up with the MUSY bulletin board, communicating with chapter members. It is a great way for them to see if they would like to pursue a future leadership role with USY.

Parents need to be encouraging and supportive of their child's decision to take on this added role that enhances their Jewish young adult experience within their synagogue.
