Minutes

September minutes were passed out and accepted.

New Business

- **Welcome:** Rhonda welcomed everyone and food was provided.
- **Introductions:** Everyone introduced themselves and signed in.
- **Fundraising:** Fundraising presentation was conducted by Melissa with Great American Opportunities and all her “Schwag” (see footnote). She suggests 2 fundraisers per calendar year, a spring and a fall. Gianna’s Handmade Baked Good to start October 20, 2014. Believe Kids and Spring BBQ were discussed.
- **Great California Shake Out Earthquake Drill:** Scheduled for Thursday, October 16, 2014 at 10:16am. Information was passed out and suggested announcements go out to families the week prior.
- **CPR/First Aid Training, Volunteer Hours, and General Membership:** Tabled until the next OCC meeting.
- **Other Items:** Harvest Feast is scheduled for November 19, 2014. Parade of Lights option for November 30, 2014. Snow Day was mentioned in lieu of Carnifall. Display My Art was suggested for February 2015. Gala scheduled for March 2015. Tighter security was suggested for Auction. All Family dance was discussed for Spring 2015. More parent supervision was highly suggested.

Old Business

- **OCC funding request:** Approved by UCEN. A separate bank account for OCC was discussed with at least 3 authorized signers with suggestion of being the 3 current OCC officers, Rhonda, Nicole, and Veronica. A copy of banking policies was requested. The UCEN Board will need to approve the change in signers at their next monthly meeting.
- **Recap Oasis Campout:** Shawn stated it was good turn out with 65+ families in attendance. We had a surplus in food. Next year’s planning is in the works. Asya

volunteered to write a recap of the campout to share with the Oasis community in an upcoming newsletter

- **Committees:** Communication committee volunteers were previously identified and were asked to organize and start having separate meetings and report back to the group in November. Dress code committee will survey families regarding a uniform policy.
- **Charter Revision:** Juanita suggested the Charter Revision be separated into 4 sections for discussion and members of the OCC can be a part of each. Alegria, E-J, Rhonda and Joanna Lonero volunteered to be the parent representatives on this committee.
