# Action Items to Increase Family Participation

- Communicate!
  - Introduce new staff members, name tags for staff members, share pictures from events, share stories from events, former parents share stories
  - Personalize the “asks”
  - Clarify the “why?” behind the importance of family participation
  - communicate the opportunities for participation
- Know the community you are serving.
