Conditions of Entry (please read carefully)

The Townsville Art Society's ('TAS') Annual Art Awards for 2012 will be held from 31 August to 16 September 2012 and are open to all financial members of the Townsville Art Society over the age of 16 as at 30 June 2012.

Number of Works Permitted - NB total of eight (8) entries per entrant

- Open Award (open to North Queensland artists, who are current members of an Art Society in North Queensland, ie north from Mackay to Cairns and west to Mount Isa) – one (1) entry per artist. **NB The artwork should reflect a regional theme.**
- Sections 2 to 8 – a maximum of one (1) entry per section. Open to TAS members only

Size

- Open Award – limited to 4.4 m in perimeter/circumference (framed or unframed)
- Sections 2 to 7 – limited to 4 m in perimeter/circumference (framed or unframed)
- Section 8 (miniature) – painting limited to 100 sq cm (eg 10 x 10 cm, 8 x 12 cm, 14 x 7 cm)
Miniatures must not exceed 30 x 20 cm when framed
- No triptych/diptych/polyptych paintings will be permitted

Framing

- Works in Sections 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 must be framed
- Unframed works must be on stretched canvas with a clean edge (eg no staples showing on outside of canvas)
- All works must be ready for hanging ('D' rings for small works 5 cm or less from top of frame; large works 8 to 10 cm from top of frame)

Entries

Entries close at 12 noon on Saturday, 11 August 2012. The TAS Awards Subcommittee reserves the right to accept late entries upon a written request detailing why the committee should accept the late entry.

Entry Fees

- Open Award: \$30
- Sections 2 to 7: \$25 per entry
- Section 8: \$15

The entry fees reflect the prize money and the cost of bringing a quality judge to Townsville.

Labels

A label is required to be completed and attached to the bottom **left hand corner** on the back of the artwork.

Costs

All freight costs, forward and return, repackaging and insurance of entries will be borne by the competitor. Packing must be of a quality to allow for its reuse for return of unsold works. A packaging fee of \$30 per entry (for freighted works only) must be enclosed with the entry form. A prepaid freight docket or freight account number must accompany the artwork. Any artwork received in packaging that cannot be reused will incur a \$30 repackaging fee. Works without return freight arrangements will not be judged and entry fees will not be refunded. Works not collected or with no return freight arrangements, at the end of the Exhibition, will become the property of the Townsville Art Society.

Commission

All works must be for sale and incur a 30% commission payable to the Perc Tucker Regional Gallery. If sponsors are offered a discount, such discount will be deducted from the commission only. Artists will receive payment from a sale from the Perc Tucker Regional Gallery. Where applicable, prices must include GST.

Removal of Works from Exhibition

Perc Tucker Regional Gallery has the discretion to remove work before the end of the Exhibition if a sale is jeopardised.

Display of Work.

Every endeavour will be made to display the artist's works to their best advantage. However, final hanging and display is done in conjunction with Perc Tucker Regional Gallery staff and no discussion regarding position will be entered into.

Judging

All eligible works will be judged. The judge's decision will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into. All awards will be allocated at the judge's discretion (eg there may be insufficient entries or the work may be below standard).

Delivery of Artworks

Works must be delivered to Perc Tucker Regional Gallery on Tuesday, 28 August between 9.00 am and 11.00 am. Freight art work may be delivered to the TAS Gallery, shops 5 – 7, 203 Kings Road, Pimlico during gallery opening hours no later than Friday, 25 August 2012.

Standards

The Townsville Art Society in conjunction with the Perc Tucker Regional Gallery reserves the right to refuse to hang works if:

- paint is not dry
- artwork not framed correctly, not conforming with specified dimensions or 'D' rings not attached correctly
- artwork is not the artist's original concept and unaided work. NB 'unaided' means not executed in classroom, or in the presence of an art teacher, qualified or unqualified. A teacher's verbal advice or opinion is considered 'assisted' if acted upon by the artist.
- artwork not executed during the past two years
- artwork previously entered in the TAS Annual Awards Exhibition and/or awarded a prize in any other awards

Please Note: Section 2 – Acrylic Award – entries in this section may include collage.

Section 3—Watercolour Award—entries in this section may be traditional or contemporary and may include collage.

Damaged or Lost Works

All due care and responsibility will be taken. However, Perc Tucker Regional Gallery and Townsville Art Society take no responsibility for any damage or loss of entry. Exhibitors display at their own risk and are advised to arrange their own insurance.

Disputes

Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down, the matter will be determined by the TAS Awards Subcommittee whose decision is final. **No discussion will be entered into if artwork is not accepted due to non fulfilment of the Conditions of Entry.**

Publicity

Work may be used for promotion and publicity and will not attract a fee. Photographing works for publicity purposes is permitted. In other instances, the approval of the artist will be sought if possible.

Collection of Entries

Artworks must be collected from the Perc Tucker Regional Gallery on Monday, 17 September. Demounting will occur between 9.00 am and 11 am. No responsibility will be taken for works not collected. Any works not collected on 17 September from Perc Tucker Regional Gallery will be held by the Townsville Art Society at 'Art on Kings' Gallery and may only be retrieved within 14 days of the date of closure, ie on or before Monday, 1 October 2012 and will incur a fee for late collection of \$20 per work. Any works not collected within this period will become the property of the Townsville Art Society.
