QUILT CAMP INFORMATION

TIME: Arrive anytime after **12:00 PM** Wednesday and choose your bunk as per your registration. Depart by 3:00 PM Sunday.

Please contact Ann Frey regarding availability of lodge beds.

MEALS: Brunch is served at 10:00 AM and dinner at 5:00 PM. If you want to bring additional food for meals, refrigerator space is available.

LOCATION: Camp N-Sid-Sen is on the east side of Lake Coeur d'Alene, 100 miles from Moscow, 9 miles north of Harrison. There are three routes:

- 1) From Moscow, Hwy 95 north to Potlatch , then Hwy 6 to St. Maries. Take Hwy 3 north out of St. Maries then keep left onto Hwy 97 toward Harrison. This route takes a solid 2 hours, is definitely scenic but very winding and we would recommend this route for daylight hours.
- 2) From Moscow, Hwy 95 north to Coeur d'Alene, then Interstate 90 East to exit 22. Turn south onto Hwy 97 to camp. This route is about 2½ hours, is not as scenic but easier and probably safer for night driving.
- 3) From Moscow, Hwy 95 north to Plummer, east on Hwy 5 to St. Maries, then north on Hwy 97 to camp. This route would take probably 2½ hours and would be safest in daylight. See attached map.

COST: The camp fee is \$185.00. A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required. If you need to come a day late or leave a day early, it is still a good deal. Where can you stay for less? It's a great weekend and there are no curfews!

ELIGIBILITY: Palouse Patchers members will be given priority enrollment. Registration is taken on a first come, first served basis.

TRANSPORTATION: You are on your own but we encourage carpooling!

WHAT TO BRING: You will need your own **bedding**, sleeping bag or sheets/blankets, pillows, towels, toiletries, and bathmats. Would also recommend **walking shoes** (it will be muddy), umbrella and **flashlight**. Please bring your sewing machine, **extension cord**, surge protector if you have a computerized machine, **light**, sewing supplies, projects, books to share, and show-and-tell items. Banquet type tables and chairs are available. You may want to bring your own sewing chair.

REQUESTS: Thank you for not bringing any alcoholic beverages, pets, children and instruments that play music. Your personal music can be played on your walkman/iPod with earphones. Please allow enough time in your schedule before departing from camp to clean up and sweep the floor in the area where you were working. It is important to show utmost courtesy to our <u>wonderful</u> camp hosts. Thank you!
