Bridleways Farm, Sandy Lane, Bishops Wood ST199AF	Objection. There are concerns regarding the increasing encroachment by development on the Green Belt. There is a significant number of residential buildings at Bridleways Farm.

15/00187/FUL	Mr & Mrs M. Baldwin	New extension and associated alterations The Old Barn, Lawn Lane, Coven WV9 5BA	This has been extended several times and as long as the development does not exceed the 30% rule, the Parish Council has no objections.
