

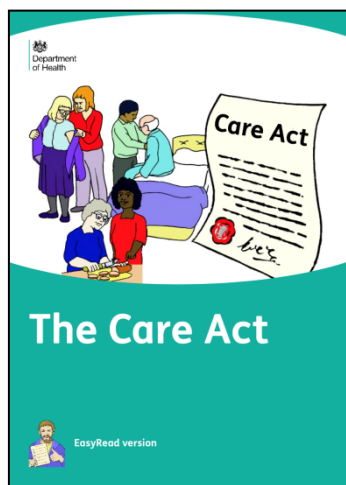
## What is Easy Read?

Easy Read is a way of writing that can help people with learning difficulties.

Easy Read should use simple words that most people understand.

An Easy Read document should use lots of pictures to help people understand and remember what they have read.

An Easy Read document should explain any words that might be hard to understand.



## The Care Act – Easy Read version

There used to be lots of different laws on care and support.

So sometimes it was hard to find out what care and support you could have.

The Care Act of 2014 makes it easier to find out what care and support there is for adults, including young people aged over 18, in England.

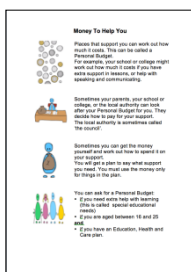

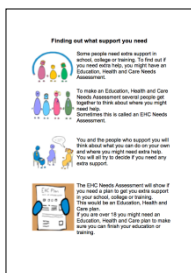

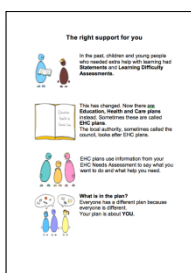
