...who need extra help with learning at school or college.



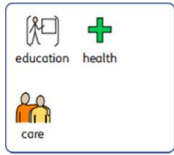
Or in an apprenticeship or supported internship.



You might also need extra help in learning to be more independent.



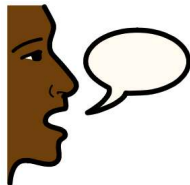
**Your school, college or trainer should support you with your extra needs.**
