When you talk to us we will **not** tell anyone outside of Supportive Parents what you said. We will keep it private.



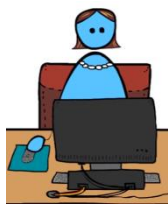
Sometimes we might think would be a good idea to talk to other people about what you tell us, such as your parents, teachers or doctors.

**You can say Yes or No.**



Sometimes we have to tell someone at Supportive Parents what you said. We might have to tell our boss so they know we are doing a good job.



We will write information about our meetings on our computers. Only people we work with will see this information.



We **will** have to tell someone if we are worried that somebody is being hurt or might be hurt.  
**If this happens, we will try to talk to you about it first.**
