Please be respectful and courteous when entering church by turning off ALL cell phones and beepers. Church is a place of worship and should be treated with reverence. Thank You.



St. Monica's is fully handicap accessible. Dedicated in 1988, St. Monica Church was the first in the Archdiocese of Chicago to be fully accessible to people with disabilities. There are no steps, all doors have levers instead of knobs, and the sanctuary is ramped.

Anointing of the Sick

The special grace of this Sacrament offers the Lord's healing strength, peace and courage to anyone who is seriously or chronically ill, hospitalized or about to undergo surgery. Please contact the Parish Office if you wish to have someone anointed.

Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated twice a month, the first Saturday of the month at 11:00 a.m. and the third Sunday of the month at 3:30 p.m. (some exceptions due to Holy Days and liturgical celebrations). Please call the Parish Office to register for the program and to set a date for the Baptism.

Marriage

Archdiocese of Chicago guidelines for marriage preparation ask that a minimum of six months be set aside for preparation for marriage. No firm date for a wedding will be set until the conclusion of the couple's first meeting with the parish minister. At least one of the engaged persons (or their parents) must be a registered and active parishioner of St. Monica. No Sunday weddings are scheduled.

Ministry to the Sick/Homebound

If you or a family member are in a local hospital or are homebound and would like to have a visit from a priest, please call the Parish Office to make arrangements. Ministers of Care are also available to bring Communion to those who are confined at home and are unable to attend Mass, either temporarily or on a continual basis. Please call the Parish Office to schedule a visit.

From the Pastor's Desk

May 5, 2013

As May begins, we begin to feel almost sentimental. May is the month of Mary, our Blessed Mother. May is the month for May Crowning, First Communions, Mother's Day, Graduations, Weddings, and Memorial Day. May is the month of endings, completions, and new beginnings. Yesterday, Saturday, May 4, some of the younger members of our Parish Family received Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist for the first time. Let us remember them and their families in our prayers. May it not only be the completion of their preparation, but the beginning of a lifetime of sharing our Lord in Holy Communion *each week*.

The Easter Season is the season of "good news." There is good news taking place when we look at our Church's work to serve those who are most in need through our charitable arms such as: St. Vincent de Paul and Catholic Charities. Through Catholic Charities, over 1.1 million people were helped last year. Catholic Charities uses various ways to continue an overwhelming amount of help. In one year, 206,000 hours of counseling were provided, more than 4.8 million meals were served, 2,000 children were better prepared for school through the Catholic Charities Head Start program, more than 1,991 children were cared for in foster homes, 1,077 homeless were cared for, over 9,000 people with critical needs (food, clothing, shelter) were assisted by the Emergency Assistance Centers, and the list goes on and on.

For more than 90 years, Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Chicago has assisted in the neighborhoods across Cook and Lake counties. They help children, families, seniors and individuals who are finding life difficult, such as those who lack the physical, emotional or financial resources to survive, and are in need of professional compassionate care. Since January, Catholic Charities has experienced an unprecedented number of people calling for help with the basic necessities of life, especially food, clothing, shelter, and rent or utility assistance. 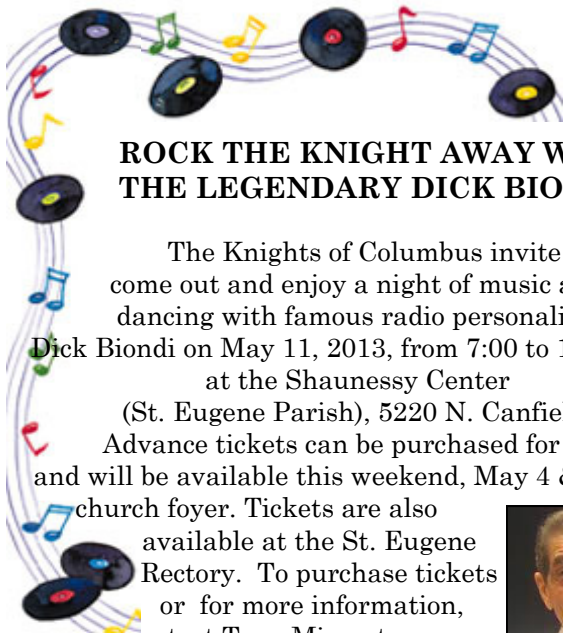

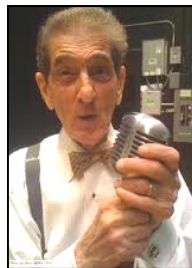

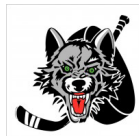

New Parishioner Registration/Parishioner Information Update Form

We warmly welcome you and are very pleased that you have chosen to celebrate Mass with us, here at St. Monica Parish. Your registration is very important, especially when it is time for infant Baptism, school registration, wedding, or funeral.

We are often asked to provide letters as affidavits for Baptismal and Confirmation sponsors. We can only do this if you are a registered and active member in our parish.
