DR. CHARLENE ARCHIBEQUE - Director

Dr. Charlene Archibeque is the Director of Choral Activities at San Jose State University, where she teaches conducting, choral methods and a graduate course in performance practices, in addition to directing the Concert Choir, Choraliers, and an evening choir for graduates, the Alumni Chorale. After attending Oberlin Conservatory and graduating with honors from the University of Michigan, she pursued the MA at San Diego State University and received the Doctor of Musical Arts from the University of Colorado in Boulder.

Dr. Archibeque is one of the most vital choral directors in America today. In addition to directing the choral program at San Jose State University, she is highly sought as a guest conductor for festival choirs, all-state choirs, and clinics across the United States and Canada as well as in Europe. In June 1986, Dr. Archibeque was the featured clinician in Melbourne for the first National Choral Symposium of the Australian Choral Association.

The San Jose State University Concert Choir and Choraliers have achieved an enviable reputation under the leadership of Dr. Archibeque having performed for 20 professional, State, Divisional, and National Conventions of both the Music Educators National Conference and the American Choral Directors Association. The Choraliers performed at the Hague International Choral Festival, the St. Moritz Festival and many of the great concert halls throughout Europe. The group was the recipient of the 1st Gold Medal in Mexico City at the International Choral Festival in 1980 and most recently appeared in Australia at the final concert of the Australian Choral Symposium in June 1986. The Choraliers were selected to perform for two concerts at the National Convention of the American Choral Directors Association in San Antonio, Texas, in March, 1987.

Dr. Archibeque is named in eight biographical listings, including the WORLD WHO'S WHO OF WOMEN IN EDUCATION and the INTERNATIONAL WHO'S WHO IN MUSIC. She was named San Jose State University's 1984-85 Outstanding Professor and is the recipient of the Distinguished Alumna Award from the University of Colorado for 1986 where she was introduced as a "Teacher of teachers."
