Students who make the top 20 in their section are eligible for All-State. The vocal score, sight-singing score, and the All-state audition score combine to determine All-State choir members. Each section will have four delegates and two alternates. You will receive a list from the district choir coordinator with your students who are all-state eligible.

All-State eligible students MUST have the All-State Choir Information sheet AND the All-State audition and selection permission form with them prior to their audition as well as the audition fee of \$10.00. There are a few changes on the audition form. Please make sure that each form is complete before submitting it.

Changes are:

1. Tri-M membership
2. Cell phone of student
3. Home address AND email address.
4. Parents address AND email address.
5. The director's ACDA number
6. Faculty representative at Tan-Tar-A

All rehearsals are at Ladue High School. The first rehearsal is Nov. 16th from 8am to 3pm. We will break 1 hour for lunch. The last rehearsal is Jan. 11th (BACK ON SATURDAY) from 8-11. The "snow day" rehearsal will be Jan. 13th (Monday) from 6-9 pm.

Medical Permission forms and All-State Code of Conduct forms are due before rehearsal begins on the FIRST rehearsal day, Nov. 16th. In addition to the form, the \$130 All-State fee is due at that time.

Medical Permission forms must have their HOME DOCTORS information. Also, YOU MUST have a copy of the students driver's license AND the insurance card FRONT AND BACK. The medical form DOES have to be notarized. Principal signature must be original, NO STAMPS.

Incomplete forms will not be accepted by Janice Bradshaw and students can be disqualified.
