MARXCRAFT has the capability to manufacture yacht furniture and fittings to any specification required from a range of exotic materials including carbon fibre, Nomex, Hexcore, GRP and HD foam.

MARXCRAFT uses computer aided drafting tools, CNC machinery and its knowledge of acoustics, lighting, fire protection, plumbing, air conditioning and audio systems to build completely integrated yacht Interiors.

Building in this fashion results in dramatically compressed project time frames as interior fabrication runs concurrently with hull construction. While in manufacture, electrical, AC and plumbing are integrated into the furniture.

At **MARXCRAFT** a large amount of emphasis is placed on decreased onsite installation time. We have developed our own fixing and installation systems beyond those in general boat building practice. This aids us in exploring this rapidly accepted method of remote interior construction.

Using these tested techniques, our clients have experienced increased levels of quality, decreased levels of financial liability, tighter integration of systems and services, and predictability of project delivery.

Carbon fibre luxury interior, made in association with McConaghy Yachts (Sydney) and Design Unlimited (London). Supply of all cabinetry, interior fittings, soft furnishings and hardware, including tap ware, bathroom fittings and electrical componentry. Project time frame – 14 months, total value – AU \$2.0 million.
