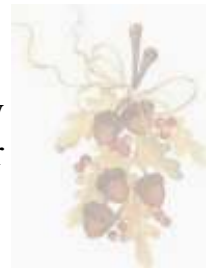
Jennifer completed an application in partnership with her lead lender, Donald Garsjo, of Yellowstone Bank of Sidney, and presented this project to the RLF committee for review. The funding request was to purchase the business, equipment and supplies.

The Pizza House has been in the community for over 40+ years, and people have come to rely on the great pizza that they get there. Jennifer plans to carry on that amazing recipe, along with some additional menu items as well. Jennifer has some exciting new ideas that she'd like to try to enhance her menu.

The RLF committee is pleased to assist Jennifer and Terri in this business venture. The intent of the RLF is to offer an additional tool to support new business and business expansion projects. Donald Garsjo states, "We are so pleased to work with the Moores to keep the Pizza House in our community. The use of the RLF funds enabled Yellowstone Bank to partner with REDC to leverage our traditional lending programs."

Lower Yellowstone Irrigation Project updates:

The public comment period for the draft Environmental Impact Study (EIS) ended on July 28th. According to the Bureau of Reclamation website, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers received 13,000 comments from various state and federal agencies, non-governmental organizations, and members of the general public. Based on the information provided by the comments received, approximately ten comments entailed scientific and technical comments, while the remaining comments were letters expressing support or opposition.



At this time in the NEPA process, the comments gathered are being considered in detail. The various agencies will meet to determine if further analysis will need to be done.

Once the final EIS is completed, there will be a 30-day notice of availability. Then the record of decision will take place.

REDC will continue to remain informed and forward this information onto the public and our membership.
