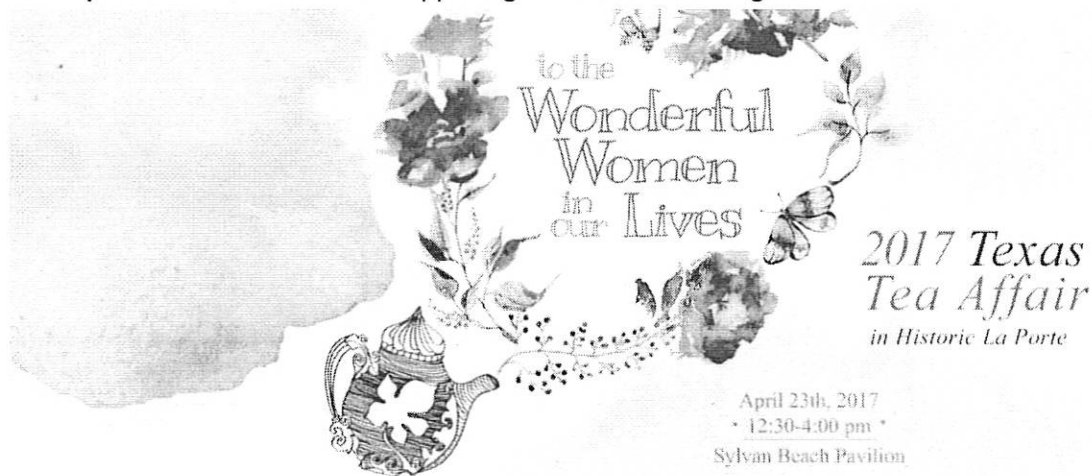
We will have a table like always!
