Happy 2014! I hope that you enjoyed the holidays with your family and friends. I am looking forward to a wonder new year for St. Hilary School.

I apologize for any inconveniences this week's school closing may have caused you. The safety of our children, families, and staff are always our first priority. Hopefully, we have seen the worst that this winter will bring and we will have no future closings. Thank you for your cooperation, understanding, and continued support.

Thank you to Mr. Jacobs and our maintenance staff for their long hours battling the snow and ensuring that the buildings are warm for the children's return.

We began our holiday break with a few special events. I am incredibly thankful to Mr. Carl Chadek and Mr. Sean Rholl for organizing the first St. Hilary School and Parish Christmas Concert. The concert was a true testament to how incredible it is when the parish and school comes together to celebrate our faith. The warm atmosphere in the church that evening was felt by all and it is my hope that we will continue to make this event an annual tradition.

Thank you also to the Advent Committee for preparing the Advent/Christmas Prayer Service on Dec. 20th. The prayer service was very meaningful. A representative from Notre Dame presented Orest Sison, an 8th grader with a special award for his 1st place finish in their Science League Challenge.

Thank you to Dr. Peg Hanrahan who worked with me to reinstate the children's pantomime at the Family Christmas Eve mass. This representation of children during the liturgy exemplified the importance of including and celebrating children at mass. The attendance at mass was overwhelming and the number of children who participated was inspiring.

Thank you to the Family School Association for their fund-raising efforts to purchase new safety mats on the stage in the Vacala Auditorium. I am very grateful to Mr. Joe Kummerer for spending his time this last weekend installing these mats.

Enclosed in this week's envelope is a very important letter explaining an accreditation process which the Archdiocese is currently in the process of obtaining. This accreditation is part of our ongoing continuous improvement process. The process

involves all stakeholders completing an online survey. The staff and children will be taking the survey during school hours. The parents also have a survey that I would appreciate you taking.

Also included in this week's envelope is a Home Language Survey. Please complete this survey for each child in your family. The results could enable St. Hilary to receive funding to help our ESL students. If you need additional copies they can be printed up from the Wednesday Envelope on our website or you can pick some up in the office.

This Friday, January 10th marks the end of the 2nd quarter; we are half way through this school year. All financial obligations must be current. What does this mean? It is very simple we are 50% through the school year therefore 50% of your tuition according to your financial obligation must be paid. As I was reviewing our tuition status I noticed that a number of families are not current in their financial obligations. The Board of Specified Jurisdiction has established a clear policy for exclusion of students whose accounts are not current (pg. 49 & 50 in the Parent/Student Handbook). Wednesday, January 15 will be an exclusion day for all students whose tuition is not current. I do not ever want to hinder a child's education, nor do I want to "punish" them for something beyond their control. That is where your responsibility comes in. Please see that your tuition is current. St. Hilary must be vigilant in paying their bills, i.e. heat, electricity, and mortgage just as you do. You receive your salary for the services that you provide your employer; our teachers must also receive their salaries. Your tuition allows these debts to be paid. I understand that you make many sacrifices to send your child to St. Hilary School. I appreciate your dedication and the priority that you have placed in allowing your child to receive a quality Catholic education. My husband and I have made those sacrifices for our own children. Our teachers are underpaid especially in comparison to CPS teachers. They make sacrifices because they too are dedicated and now that teaching at St. Hilary is a calling and service to others.

On Saturday, January 11, 2014 our 8th graders will be taking their high school placement tests. Please keep them in your prayers as they begin the process of continuing this new journey in their education.

On December 21Cardinal Francis George celebrated the 50th Anniversary of his ordination as a priest. The children sent him cards. Enclosed please find the thank you letter that I received from the Cardinal.

Our website www.sthilarychicago.org will also have closing information. We will close if the Archdiocese closes and if CPS Closes – extremely rare events. You should choose, based on your own judgment and situation, whether or not to keep your child (ren) home.
