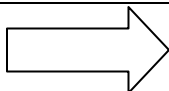

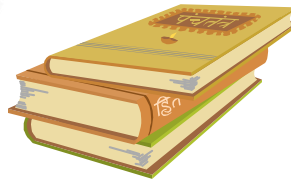

**iBreviary** - iBreviary was one of the first Catholic [smartphone](#) apps available, and I think it’s still one of the most handy apps to have on your phone. As you might guess from its name, it provides you with an electronic breviary, the book used to pray the Liturgy of the Hours. *This app is available on: [iPhone](#), [iPad](#), [Android](#) and [Kindle Fire](#).*



**Mea Culpa** - Mea Culpa helps make you a good confession. In addition to a great examination, it has a Confession FAQ section and if you can’t find an answer to your Confession questions there, you can ask your question by email. The bread and butter of this app is the examination, and it does it well. *This app is available on [iTunes](#)*



**Laudate** - comprehensive free Catholic App . Daily Mass Readings (with Saint of the Day and Reflections). Liturgy of Hours, New American Bible, interactive Rosary and Chaplet of [Divine Mercy](#), Seven Sorrows Rosary, Chaplet of St. Michael, Franciscan Crown Rosary, Latin Rosary, Stations of the Cross, searchable prayers and latin prayers with English translation. Douay-Rheims Bible for offline use. Multiple podcasts for daily meditations and Rosary. Catechism of Catholic Church with ability to bookmark and share. My Prayers lets you store your own prayers and move them between iPad and iPhone. Confession guides through sacrament of reconciliation. **Mass Times** - This app uses your location to find the nearest parish and gives you the Mass times at those locations. You can also search for a particular church and bookmark your favorites. ## Lenten Spiritual Direction

Spiritual what? Spiritual Direction. Ask ten Spiritual Directors to define what they do and you are likely to get ten different answers, yet all will share a set of core ideas. **Spiritual Direction is...**

1. **An ancient ministry in the church.**
2. **A safe place** to explore your questions and concerns about your life with God.
3. **A respected and respectful interpersonal relationship** in which you learn how to grow, live, and love in the spiritual life.
4. **A process** through which one person helps another or others understand what God is doing and saying in their lives.

Spiritual Direction can be done individually or in a group format. Today one can even engage in Spiritual direction on line. Individuals, alone or together, meet with a Spiritual Director. **To be a spiritual director one must be...**

- a person rooted in faith and personally committed to an active prayer life
- trained in the arts of attentive listening, spiritual discernment and encouragement as well as advanced study in theology, spirituality and scripture
- experienced in using and directing others to use a wide range of spiritual practices.

Everything discussed in spiritual direction is done from the perspective of one's relationship with God. This is the unique gift of spiritual direction, and one of the main differences between it and other forms of counseling. In the process of Spiritual Direction both the director and directee search for and find the way God is moving and working in their lives. Confidentiality and hospitality are hallmarks of the ministry of Spiritual Direction as is the commitment to prayer.

Here at St. Hilary we are blessed to have both men and women trained as Spiritual Directors. If this sounds like something that might be helpful to you this Lent

- join the **Lenten Spiritual Direction Group**
- or **request a Spiritual Director** that will meet with you individually.

**The Lenten Spiritual Direction Group** will meet on Wednesday evenings, beginning on Ash Wednesday, in the Rectory from 7-8:30 pm (except for Ash Wednesday which will meet after the 7:30 evening Mass). Each week we will read the Gospel for the upcoming Sunday. We will spend time with the reading, reflecting and praying with it, seeing how it impacts us and how we can carry that impact into the coming week. This group is open to both men and women. You can attend all of the weekly sessions or participate on those Wednesdays when you are able. There is no fee for participating in this group.

One of the available Spiritual Directors will get back to you to set up an initial meeting.

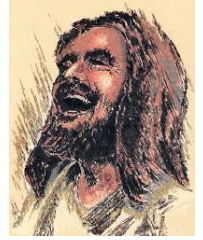
