Last year you were asked to complete a parent survey for our AdvancEd accreditation process; this year AdvancEd has added a Catholic identity survey that we need you to complete. It is important that you take a few minutes to complete this short survey. I ask that this be completed by Friday, February 12th. Four parents have already completed it; however, that is not enough data for us to identify our strengths and areas for improvement. I thank you, in advance, for helping us serve you better. Reminders:

Registration for the 2016-2017 school year has begun. This year we will be implementing a new on-line registration process. It is our hope that this will make registrations easier for you and help us to keep all information compiled more efficiently. If we have a current email address on file for you, you should have received an email from Infosnap with a personal "Snap Code" that you will need to complete the on-line registration form. You will receive the traditional Powerschool Student Data form to reregister today if you would like to use that option. Please review the form, make any necessary corrections, complete the tuition payment preference form, and return these forms to school with the \$100.00 registration fee. The registration fee will increase to \$200.00 for any registration after March 11, 2016. Thank you to the many families who have already completed their registration. We are very fortunate to have new prospective families inquiring about seats for next year, spaces may soon be limited so please be proactive and register early.

This year, once again, St. Hilary will be utilizing the FACTS management program for our financial aid process. There is a link on our school's website for the FACTS program. This is the same organization that serves as our tuition management program. It is more efficient for everyone to incorporate both of these services in one program. The application is now available for you. Please see the letter in today's envelope for more details.

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for St. Hilary for the upcoming 2016-2017 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by June 30, 2016. Applicants can apply online, the link can be found on our school website - www.sthilarychicago.org. Once an online application has been completed, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the application process:

- Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
- Copies of your 2015 W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

All supporting documentation can be uploaded in PDF format online.

Documentation can also be faxed to 1-866-315-9264 or mailed to the address below. Please be sure to include the applicant ID on all faxed or mailed correspondence.


