### Consent and Authorization

Although their occurrence is not frequent, some risk and complications are known to be associated with dental or oral surgery procedures. The most common complications associated with pediatric dental treatment include nausea following the administration of topical fluoride and children biting and injuring their tongue or lip following the administration of local anesthesia. Less complications include the risk of numbness, infection, swelling, prolonged bleeding, discoloration, vomiting, allergic reactions, swallowing or aspiration of a crown from an extracted tooth or gauze packing; injury to the tongue and/or lips, damage to and possible loss of existing teeth and/or restorations (fillings), injury to nerves near the treatment site and fracture of a tooth root which may require additional surgery for its removal. For children with heart disease, the risk of sub-acute bacterial endocarditis (heart infection) following dental treatment exists; therefore antibiotics will be prescribed before and following treatment, to minimize the risk.

I hereby state that I have read and understand this consent form, that I have been given opportunity to ask questions I might have and that all questions about the procedure(s) have been answered in a satisfactory manner and I understand further that I have the right to be provided with answers to questions which may arise during the course of my child's treatment. For example: You purchase a \$100 gift card which has a 4% discount then you receive a \$2.00 rebate and St. Hilary will receive a \$2.00 donation.

### **What do I do with my rebate?**

You can use your rebate towards reducing your tuition, your book fee, purchase gym uniforms, after school care or add to your lunch card and as always you can buy more gift cards. You can even donate your rebate to the school which will be used towards the school technology program.

### **Can I give out the gift cards as gifts to others?**

Yes, you can! In fact we encourage you to purchase all your gift cards through SCP! You can purchase a wide variety of gift cards from Jewel, Dicks, The home Depot just to name a few. Gift cards are great for birthday gifts, stocking stuffers and everything in between. And remember most cards do not have an expiration date, so they can be used at any future date.

### **Count me in! How do you place an order?**

Orders can be placed anytime with cash or check (made payable to the school). If your card is out of stock we place an order on Monday's and delivered on Tuesday's. If you have a student in the school, gift cards will be sent home with your student. Otherwise gift cards can be picked up in the main office during regular business hours.
