Consent and Authorization

Although their occurrence is not frequent, some risk and complications are known to be associated with dental or oral surgery procedures. The most common complications associated with pediatric dental treatment include nausea following the administration of topical fluoride and children biting and injuring their tongue or lip following the administration of local anesthesia. Less complications include the risk of numbness, infection, swelling, prolonged bleeding, discoloration, vomiting, allergic reactions, swallowing or aspiration of a crown from an extracted tooth or gauze packing; injury to the tongue and/or lips, damage to and possible loss of existing teeth and/or restorations (fillings), injury to nerves near the treatment site and fracture of a tooth root which may require additional surgery for its removal. For children with heart disease, the risk of sub-acute bacterial endocarditis (head infection) following dental treatment exists; therefore antibiotics will be prescribed before and following treatment, to minimize the risk.

I hereby state that I have read and understand this consent form, that I have been given opportunity to ask questions I might have and that all questions about the procedure(s) have been answered in a satisfactory manner and I understand further that I have the right to be provided with answers to questions which may arise during the course of my child's treatment. By signing this form I consent and authorize the doctors of Mobile CARE Foundation to furnish dental treatment on my child.

Consentimiento y Autorización

Aunque su ocurrencia no es frecuente, algunos riesgos y complicaciones se sabe que están asociados con procedimientos de cirugía dentales o orales. Las complicaciones más comunes asociados con el tratamiento dental pediátrico incluyen náuseas después de la administración tópica de fluoruro, morder o herir a su lengua o el labio después de la administración de la anestesia local. Menos complicaciones incluyen el riesgo de entumecimiento , infección , inflamación , sangrado prolongado , decoloración, vómitos, reacciones alérgicas , la deglución o aspiración de una corona de un diente extraído o gasas ; lesión en la lengua y / o de los labios , y daños a la posible pérdida de los dientes existentes y / o restauraciones (rellenos), lesión a los nervios cerca del sitio de tratamiento y fractura de una raíz de diente que puede requerir cirugía adicional para su eliminación. Para los niños con enfermedades del corazón, el riesgo de endocarditis bacteriana (infección cabeza) después del tratamiento dental existe ; Por lo tanto, los antibióticos se prescriben antes y después del tratamiento , para minimizar el riesgo .
