Dear Parent/Guardian.

As the weather turns the flu season will soon be here. Please keep in mind that neither children nor adults are able to focus and learn when they are not 100%. Please allow your child to regain their health and strength before returning to school, this will also help to reduce the spreading of germs to others. Children do need to be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school. We appreciate your cooperation as we continue to keep everyone's safety a top priority.

Speaking of safety, tomorrow in cooperation with the Chicago Police Department we will be having a lockdown drill. Your child has been learning about the importance of this drill. As with any of our drills, the purpose is to keep your child safe. I encourage you to talk to your child to answer any questions they may have. This drill can be compared to using a seat belt in the car, locking the doors in your house, staying near mom and dad while in public, and our monthly fire drills, in regards to their importance. We do not want children to panic or feel that there is a potential threat, there is not, practice is a necessary part of preparedness and foresight. We did conduct a drill yesterday and unfortunately a number of students did not take this seriously, it is our hope that we will have a more successful drill tomorrow.

You will be receiving a conference request form for our Parent-Teacher-Student conferences, in today's envelope, which will be held on Oct. 13th and Oct. 14th. In order to serve you, our parents, better you will have the option of two days to conference with your child's teacher(s). <u>Please complete the request form indicating your preference of date and time and return by October 3rd.</u> If you do not return your request form a date and time will be scheduled for you. The faculty will meet together and do our best to schedule your conference as close to your preferred time as possible. You will receive a confirmation of your scheduled time and date on Friday, October 7th

Yesterday each family received one copy of the Kidstuff coupon book to purchase. You have two choices: one, you can purchase the book sending payment to school in the white envelope or two, return the book to school if you do not wish to purchase it. In addition you may be purchase additional copies for your family and friends by using the order form. This is a fund-raiser hosted by the Family & School Association to help replace funds previously obtained through Market Day which was dissolved last year.

Please read the directions on the yellow sheet very carefully. Thank you for your consideration in supporting these efforts.

Last week a flyer for Art Studio came home and there was some confusion. These sessions are for our $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ graders. Mrs. Rhodes will be holding two different art classes for our younger children and your child will receive this information from Mrs. Rhodes during their art classes.
