Dear Parent/Guardian,

Congratulations to Archbishop Cupich on his elevation to Cardinal! The ceremony will be held on Sat. November 19th at the Basilica of St. Peter in Vatican City. We will honor this special day with a "Dress in Red Day" on Fri. Nov. 18th. All students, faculty, and staff will be asked to dress in their red uniform polo in support and recognition of Archbishop Cupich. In addition, we will be sending a special prayer or drawing to him from all of the children, faculty, and staff. This is a historic event and the children will be learning more about this process in their religion classes.

Today your child will be bringing home their first trimester progress report. Please take some time to review this with your child. 


