Dear Parent/Guardian,

On Friday we will celebrate the feast day of St. Hilary. He was a wise man ahead of his time, he stood firm in his beliefs in studying and taking the opportunity to learn and share our faith. We should be proud to be a part of a community that bears his name.

Friday, January 20th marks the half way point of the 2nd trimester. Please be vigilant with your financial obligations. Parent-teacher-student conferences are scheduled for Friday, January 27th. A conference request form is included in today's envelope. These conferences are **not** mandatory for every child. They are based on teacher and/or parent requests. Please return the conference form to school by Wednesday, January 18th. You will receive notification if a teacher has requested to see you regarding your child's progress in today's envelope. If you do not receive notification of a requested conference and you do not wish to schedule a conference no further letter will be sent home to you. Confirmation of schedule times will be sent home on Friday, January 20th. If you have any questions on this process please do not hesitate to contact me either by email or phone.

Thank you to those families who have really prioritized punctuality in their child's lives. Unfortunately we have had to issue 9 ARPs so far during this 2nd trimester. That is equivalent to 27 days tardy for our children. To put this in perspective we have been in school for 26 days this trimester. Please make sure that your child is on time for school each day, this will instill in them the importance of punctuality as they learn these life skills at a very early age. Each ARP that is issued requires the teachers to be here earlier than they are required and they do so because they know the importance of this life skill. Please be respectful of their time as well.

Our 8th graders:

Attention all 7th grade parents:

I highly recommend the PEACE program if you are looking for any test prep program for your child. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

PEACE Educational Services will be conducting a **10 week Aspire Preparation Program for 7th graders here at Northside Catholic Academy** on Saturdays beginning January 14th from 12:30-3:00 at the Middle School Campus at 7318 N. Oakley. Students will prepare for **Reading Comprehension, Writing, Math Reasoning, and Math Constructed Response.** Why is this important? **The Aspire test is somewhat new and challenging exam. Many high schools use the 7th grade Aspire results as one important component of the application when considering admission and placement, and PEACE helps your child's full ability to be reflected in the test results.** PEACE will review content and give format-specific practice. Moreover, PEACE instills confidence and teaches test taking skills which will help on future tests. Reminders:

As winter is now upon us please remember to dress your child appropriately. As stated in our handbook we will have indoor recess if the temperature is 25 degrees or below real or with wind chill. Please make sure that your child has a warm coat, hat and gloves so that they are safe in these temperatures. If your child wears boots to school, please make sure to send a pair of shoes for them to change into when they arrive. I appreciate your cooperation and understanding in this matter.

Emergency Closing/Cold Weather

Cold weather: Students will be kept in for indoor recess when the temperature is below 25 degrees (actually or with wind chill) or in wet rainy/snowy conditions. Please make sure your child comes prepared to go outdoors – gloves, scarf, hat or hood. This is especially true of those who are on patrol.

Emergency Closing Information

Our School Messenger system will notify you either by phone or email in the event of our school closing due to weather. In addition, emergency closing information will be announced on WBBM Radio Newsradio 780 and WGN Radio 720. The television stations to watch are CBS Channel 2 Chicago, Channel 5, ABC Channel 7 Chicago, WGN Morning News, Fox 32 and CLTV News. We will close if the Archdiocese is closed as a system, an extremely rare event. You should choose, based on your own judgment and situation, whether or not to keep your child(ren) home.
