This weekend Fr. Aloy and Fr. Tom invite the St. Hilary community to receive the Anointing of the Sick at all masses. Fr. Aloy will anoint those who attend the 9:30 mass at the chapel on Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. "This sacrament helps unite those who are suffering with Jesus' saving and healing power is the Anointing of the Sick. Through this sacrament people receive forgiveness for their sins and comfort in their suffering; they are restored in spirit; and sometimes they even experience the return of physical health. Suffering is a part of life, but Jesus unites our suffering with his passion and death so that through our suffering we can participate in his saving and healing work. The sacrament also reminds us that God wants to give comfort to the suffering and wants us to relieve suffering where we can."

On Friday St. Hilary took part in our AdvancEd accreditation review. A Regional Director and principal from the Archdiocese came to visit us and reviewed many articles of evidence to support our curriculum, test scores, mission, governing body, Catholic Identity, survey results and much more. I am proud to share with you that the team was impressed with St. Hilary and shared very kind remarks about our community, academic program, test scores, and Catholic Identity. We will receive the final report in a few weeks and I will share the results with you. This review is a process that identifies our strengths and will suggest improvement areas. We will carefully analysis the report and take steps towards continuing to improve ourselves for the benefit of our children. Thank you to our AdvancEd team Ms. Montemurro, Mrs. Ewen, Mr. Andre, and Mr. Donnelly who worked very hard to complete all necessary documents and collect all evidence. The amount of time and energy that they put forth in this process is greatly appreciated, especially Ms. Montemurro who was our teacher chairperson.


## THE PLAYGROUND IS COMING!!




