Moreover, recipients energetically build bridges to the parish, neighborhood, and wider community through exceptional communication and collaboration. I am very humbled to have been presented this award. I feel that this is an award for all of us, we are such an amazing community of people whose dedication to our faith and our children is priceless. Thank you for always being supportive and loyal to St. Hilary School and Parish.

Congratulations to our 1<sup>st</sup> Communicants! Saturday was a beautiful day, the sun was shining and all of the children were fantastic. Thank you to Mrs. Whitney Castle, Ms. Katrina Giannoni and Dc. Juan Ramirez for preparing the children for this special sacrament. We are excited that they were able to receive communion today with the entire school at mass. A couple of weeks ago I announced 4 of our students who were selected as the top 100 finalists in the Do the Write Thing National Campaign against violence. Last night these students; Lina, Annabelle, Raymond, and Jaden were recognized and celebrated at a special dinner. There were a total of 1500 essays that were submitted and we are extremely proud that these 4 students were recognized for their insight and ability to express themselves so well. Congratulations to Deni Paskali who was selected to become a Daniel Murphy Scholar. This is a four year scholarship. Deni will be attending St. Ignatius College Prep in the

#### Safety:

How would you feel if your child was hurt by a car on our campus? How would you feel if you hurt one of our children with your car? These are questions that I pray you never have to answer. Once again, I have been notified of reckless driving around our campus. These behaviors are unacceptable and some are against the law, when posted signs are ignored. I beg of you to be 150% aware of children at all times. It saddens me that I continuously need to ask this of you but I will not stop until you do. Again I say that the safety of our children is our 1<sup>st</sup> priority I hope that it is yours as well.

#### Reminder:

With the year quickly coming to a close I ask that your tuition balance is current. 8<sup>th</sup> graders tuition must be paid in full by May 15<sup>th</sup> or your child will be excluded from events and activities, including participating in graduation. Preschool and kindergarten children will be excluded from the end of the year celebrations if their tuition account is not paid.


