Attention 7th graders:

This year's Catholic High School Entrance Exam (*HSPT*) will take place on December 2nd which is 6 weeks earlier than in previous years. *PEACE* Educational Services is conducting a comprehensive 8 week High School Entrance Exam Preparation Program. *The PEACE Program provides skill review, format specific practice, and confidence building to ensure that students' full ability is reflected on the HSPT.* Information on the program and the *PEACE* brochure are in today's envelope. Reminder:

Just a reminder that June 9th will be the last day of school with a 10:45 a.m. dismissal. We will be attending mass together as a school at 8:30 and then will celebrate all our accomplishments this year with an award ceremony. All are welcome to join us for these special celebrations. The Family School Association will host an end of the year picnic immediately following dismissal in the parking lot, where a hot dog lunch will be provided. Our 8th graders, preschoolers, and kindergartners are welcome to come back and join us.

Also, next year each family will, once again, be required to use the FACTS Tuition Management System as mandated by the Archdiocese. There are a few choices that you will need to make in setting up your account.

First, you have the choice of having your tuition payments automatically withdrawn from your bank account or you can choose the invoice option. This option will allow you to receive an invoice from FACTS and then your payment can be made either through FACTS or payment may be brought into the school office.

Secondly, you need to choose your payment plan; either full payment (no FACTS service fee) where you will receive a 3% discount on your tuition payment if it is made by September 1st. There is also a 2 payment option (a onetime \$10.00 FACTS service fee) where your tuition balance is divided in two parts, one paid in September and one in January. The final option is a monthly payment plan (a onetime \$30.00 FACTS service fee), spread out over 10 months – August to May.



HSPT TEST PREP

You've had a great elementary education so why is HSPT test prep so important?

The HSPT, a one-time test for 8th graders entering Catholic high schools, is used to determine admittance, track placement, and, in some circumstances, whether scholarship dollars will be awarded. While a good elementary education is the best preparation, students' true ability may not be reflected, as they may be anxious, are often unfamiliar with the format of the test. or may need to review relevant material taught in previous grades.
