### **Attention 7<sup>th</sup> graders:**

This year's Catholic High School Entrance Exam (*HSPT*) will take place on December 2<sup>nd</sup> which is 6 weeks earlier than in previous years. *PEACE* Educational Services is conducting a comprehensive 8 week High School Entrance Exam Preparation Program. ***The PEACE Program provides skill review, format specific practice, and confidence building to ensure that students' full ability is reflected on the HSPT.*** Information on the program and the *PEACE* brochure are in today's envelope. ### **Reminder:**

Just a reminder that June 9<sup>th</sup> will be the last day of school with a 10:45 a.m. dismissal. We will be attending mass together as a school at 8:30 and then will celebrate all our accomplishments this year with an award ceremony. All are welcome to join us for these special celebrations. The Family School Association will host an end of the year picnic immediately following dismissal in the parking lot, where a hot dog lunch will be provided. Our 8<sup>th</sup> graders, preschoolers, and kindergartners are welcome to come back and join us.

Also, next year each family will, once again, be required to use the FACTS Tuition Management System as mandated by the Archdiocese. There are a few choices that you will need to make in setting up your account.

First, you have the choice of having your tuition payments automatically withdrawn from your bank account or you can choose the invoice option. This option will allow you to receive an invoice from FACTS and then your payment can be made either through FACTS or payment may be brought into the school office.

Secondly, you need to choose your payment plan; either full payment (no FACTS service fee) where you will receive a 3% discount on your tuition payment if it is made by September 1<sup>st</sup>. There is also a 2 payment option (a onetime \$10.00 FACTS service fee) where your tuition balance is divided in two parts, one paid in September and one in January. The final option is a monthly payment plan (a onetime \$30.00 FACTS service fee), spread out over 10 months – August to May.

HSPT TEST PREP

## You've had a great elementary education so why is HSPT test prep so important?

The HSPT, a one-time test for 8th graders entering Catholic high schools, is used to determine admittance, track placement, and, in some circumstances, whether scholarship dollars will be awarded. While a good elementary education is the best preparation, students' true ability may not be reflected, as they may be anxious, are often unfamiliar with the format of the test, or may need to review relevant material taught in previous grades.



## HSPT Prep Course Curriculum



### Individualized Diagnostics

Students begin the course by taking a diagnostic test in order to identify individual strengths and weaknesses which helps our teachers to maximize each student's results.



### Comprehensive Review of the Academic Skills Tested on the HSPT

Experienced Math and Language Arts teachers will lead instruction to review all areas of the test, including:

- **Verbal Skills:** Analogies, Synonyms, Logic, Verbal Classifications, Antonyms
- **Quantitative Skills:** Number Series, Geometric Comparison, Nongeometric Comparison, Number Manipulation
- **Reading:** Comprehension, Vocabulary
- **Mathematics:** Concepts, Problem-Solving
- **Language Skills:** Punctuation and Capitalization, Usage, Spelling, Composition



### Format Specific Practice

At the end of each class session, students will take a mini-assessment in the format of that section of the test. This familiarity with the test format will play a significant role in reducing their anxiety, allowing their full potential to be accurately reflected on the test. Students take a full HSPT on the final day.



### PEACE Skills

What sets us apart is our focus on our students developing confidence in their ability to perform well which is essential to their success. During our PEACE Skill sessions, we cover topics such as time management, goal setting, and reflection on personal growth.
