- Registration kicks off for the 2018-2019 school year.

 - Each child who registers on Sunday will receive a special gift

Remember to assure a seat for your child next year and register early. Take advantage of the Registration Raffle on Jan. 28th for a chance to win free registration fees. Catholic Schools Week is a time when we celebrate and focus on the value that Catholic education provides to our young people and its contributions to our church, our communities, and our nation. 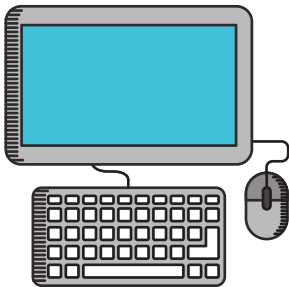
