Dear Parent/Guardian,

The ACT Aspire testing is under way for 3rd – 8th graders. It is extremely important that your child is on time for school this week; once the test has begun students will not be allowed to enter the classroom and will need to make up the test on a different day. These tests are only a portion of our day and academic instruction will continue. Results will be shared with you once they are sent back to us.

Our partnership with Big Shoulders has provided scholarships for our families, professional development for our teachers, service projects completed around our campus and now **FREE** vision and hearing screenings. On Monday April 30th and Tuesday May 1st the following grades will receive free screenings: preschool, kindergarten and 2nd grade both vision and hearing – 1st thru 3rd grade hearing – 5th thru 8th vision. Students in 1st and 3rd can also receive the vision screening if requested. Parents will receive a report and vouchers for VisionWorks are available. If you do not want your child to participate please indicate that in writing and send the note to school with your child. I am very grateful for all that Big Shoulders provides for St. Hilary.

Tax Credit Scholarship update:

Big Shoulders:

On Friday April 13, Big Shoulders sent award emails to over 1,100 students. At this point, they have awarded close to \$6.8 million to families. The first step for a family is to bring their School Commitment Form to the school they selected in the application. This form is how they will know that a) the family is choosing to accept the scholarship and b) that St. Hilary is accepting the student.

Empower Illinois:

Empower Illinois began communicating award status to TCS applicants, on Monday, April 2. Award letters will continue to be mailed out weekly on Mondays.

Families can expect to see one of the following types of letters:

- Award Confirmation Letter Scholarship confirmed; (school enrollment letter previously provided)
- <u>Conditional</u> Award Confirmation Letter Scholarship confirmed; need to supply acceptance/enrollment letter from school
- <u>Provisional</u> Award Confirmation Letter- Eligibility confirmed; pending acceptance/enrollment letter form from *recognized* school
- Scholarship Denied Letter Applicant deemed ineligible
- Application Incomplete Letter Eligibility could not be determined; reapply (lost original first come-first served date/time stamp)
- Non-Priority Letter Applicant received non-priority status; review will be deferred until review of priority applicants complete
- Waitlist Letter Application received but unprocessed; will not be reviewed for eligibility unless additional funds become available.

Each year the 7th and 8th grade students write essays that are submitted to the National Campaign against violence. This campaign is entitled, "Do the Write Thing". This year 7 of our students were selected amongst the 100 finalists in the Chicago land area. These students are: Gail Carreon, Thao Dang, Alexandra Davalos, Sidonie Habert, Adhrian Rodriquez, Phuc Tran, and Janine Villamayor. They will be honored at a recognition awards dinner on May 8th. The two first place winners will be announced at the dinner and will receive an expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. in June. Congratulations on this incredible honor, we are very proud of you! 

- 4. **Submit:** Submit the form with your attached photo by **April 24, 2018**. (An individual student may not submit more than 3 separate photos.)
