Dear Parent/Guardian,

Yesterday at mass Fr. Tom challenged all of us to take some time this week to tell someone about God. During the Renew My Church Summit we were all reminded that renewing the church starts with discussions about God, welcoming everyone to be an active part of the church. Renewing the church really means renewing ourselves, our faith and sharing that with others. I hope that you will join in the challenge and see how you can make a difference in someone's life while moving forward with helping to renew our church.

Yesterday our fire alarm went off unexpectedly. Everyone exited the building quickly and the Chicago Fire Department came. We discovered that we have a problem with one of the smoke detectors on the 2nd floor of the convent building. Maintenance and I are working on fixing this problem. I wanted you to be aware of this incident and to be assured that everyone followed the emergency protocol keeping all of us safe.

Next week, October 11th & 12th we will hold our first trimester progress report conferences. We will dismiss at 11:30 am on Thursday and Friday. <u>These conferences</u> <u>are mandatory and your child is expected to attend. We are a team and will work</u> <u>together better when everyone is present</u>. Thank you to all the families for returning your conference request forms. You will receive your confirmation letter with your child's conference time on Friday, October 5th. If you would like to meet with teachers that you have not scheduled a time with please refer to each teacher's schedule which will be posted outside of their class. It is important for us to be respectful of the families whose conferences were scheduled originally.

Friday, October 6th marked the halfway point of our first trimester. Your financial obligations to Saint Hilary must be taken care of in a timely manner. Per board policy, students whose tuition and fees have not been kept up to date by the end of the trimester will be subject to exclusion on Wednesday November 29th.

Today your child will be bringing home their first trimester progress report. Please take some time to review this with your child. We are excited to meet with you next week at our conferences. This is a wonderful opportunity to discuss your child's strengths and ways that we can continue to help them improve. Your child's education and success are possible because of the teamwork between all of us.

Medical forms:

All children new to St. Hilary need medical, dental, and vision forms. Preschoolers need medical and vision forms. Kindergarteners need medical and dental forms. 2nd graders need dental forms and 6th graders need medical and dental forms. According to the Illinois State Board of Education students are to be excluded from school by October 15 if these health and immunization requirements have not been met.

- Sexual Harassment Training Program found on your Virtus dashboard
- Coaches/Scout leaders are also required to complete the Mandated Reporter Training

You may notice that there have been an addition to the volunteer requirements; the sexual harassment training program. This program is completed online and you will receive a certificate which you need to submit to school and it will be kept on file. Scout leaders and coaches are also required to complete the Mandated Reporter Training. Again, this is an on-line program and your certificate also needs to be submitted to school.
