Preparation (read about culture, dress code, climate, Intercommunication)

Information; MRSA-test, Lunch, communications, what to do if you are sick

Inform / make the student understand the institution if they are ...

Criminal documents – sending institution needs information on whether the exchange student has a criminal record (the receiving institution provides information)

written clear guidelines concerning how to understand how things are done at the hosting intuition

Learning Agreement

Student supervision, Individual learning from home institution.

Clinical supervision, agreement upon learning outcome prior to clinical placement

Exchange requirements (Write a personal letter, CV, Language skills, Evaluation)

Information on what the exchange students experience is provided for the clinical staff

Student buddies. Buddies –from the receiving institutions

Social program provided by the receiving institution
