## For Immediate Release

BCICA is aware that in some instances, mechanical contractors have not used BCICA Members to install work that requires a Quality Assurance Certificate (QAC). Unfortunately, the specifying authority may not be aware of this oversight until well into the job and therefore may be required to compromise his / her specification due to time constraints. BCICA will not provide a QAC to an insulation contractor that is not a member of the Association. In order to avoid this issue, BCICA advises specifiers to insist that mechanicals comply with the specification by tendering QAC work only to Members of BCICA.

One way that a specifier can avoid this issue altogether, and insure that the mechanical insulation work is performed by trained professionals, is to add a paragraph to the mechanical insulation specifications similar to the following:

## Section xxxxx - Insulation - Piping and Equipment

## 1.x Acceptable Insulation Contractors

.x Contractor must be a member of the British Columbia Insulation Contractors Association.
