LIFEGUARD INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION

This course provides necessary training and information for participants to certify YMCA lifeguards and YMCA Aquatic Safety Assistants (YASA). This course is 27 hours and automatically renews YMCA lifeguard certification.
