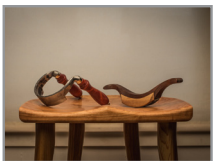


### SIMPLER SLOWER SILVER

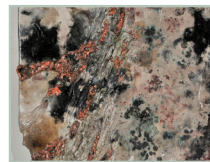


### RELOCATIONS
